ORDINANCE # 237

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA, REQUIRING HOUSE NUMBERS TO BE PLACED ON ALL RESIDENTIAL AND/OR COMMERCIAL STRUCTURES IN THE TOWN OF CARNEGIE, OKLAHOMA

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Trustees of Carnegie, Oklahoma:

SECTION 1.

All owners or persons in possession of residential and/or commercial structures in the Town of Carnegie, Oklahoma shall be required to place or mount prominently on the front of each such structure numbers approved or assigned by the Town Clerk reflecting that property's address or house number. Said numbers shall be in numerical form and be at least three (3) inches in height and in contrasting color to the balance of the structure.

SECTION 2.

That no utilities shall be provided to such structures until said numbers are assigned and placed or mounted thereon.

SECTION 3.

Penalty imposed: In addition to withholding utilities subject to Section 2 hereinabove, any violation of this ordinance shall be deemed an offense and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine in the amount of \$15.00. Every month in which a violation continues shall be a separate offense.

SECTION 3.

Effective date: This ordinance shall be in force and effect assuming its prior passage, approval and publication beginning January 1, 2006.
